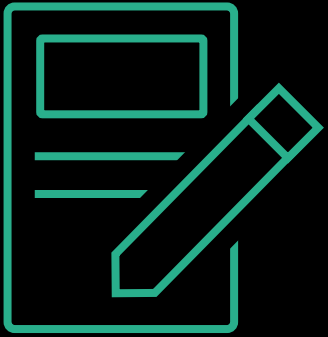

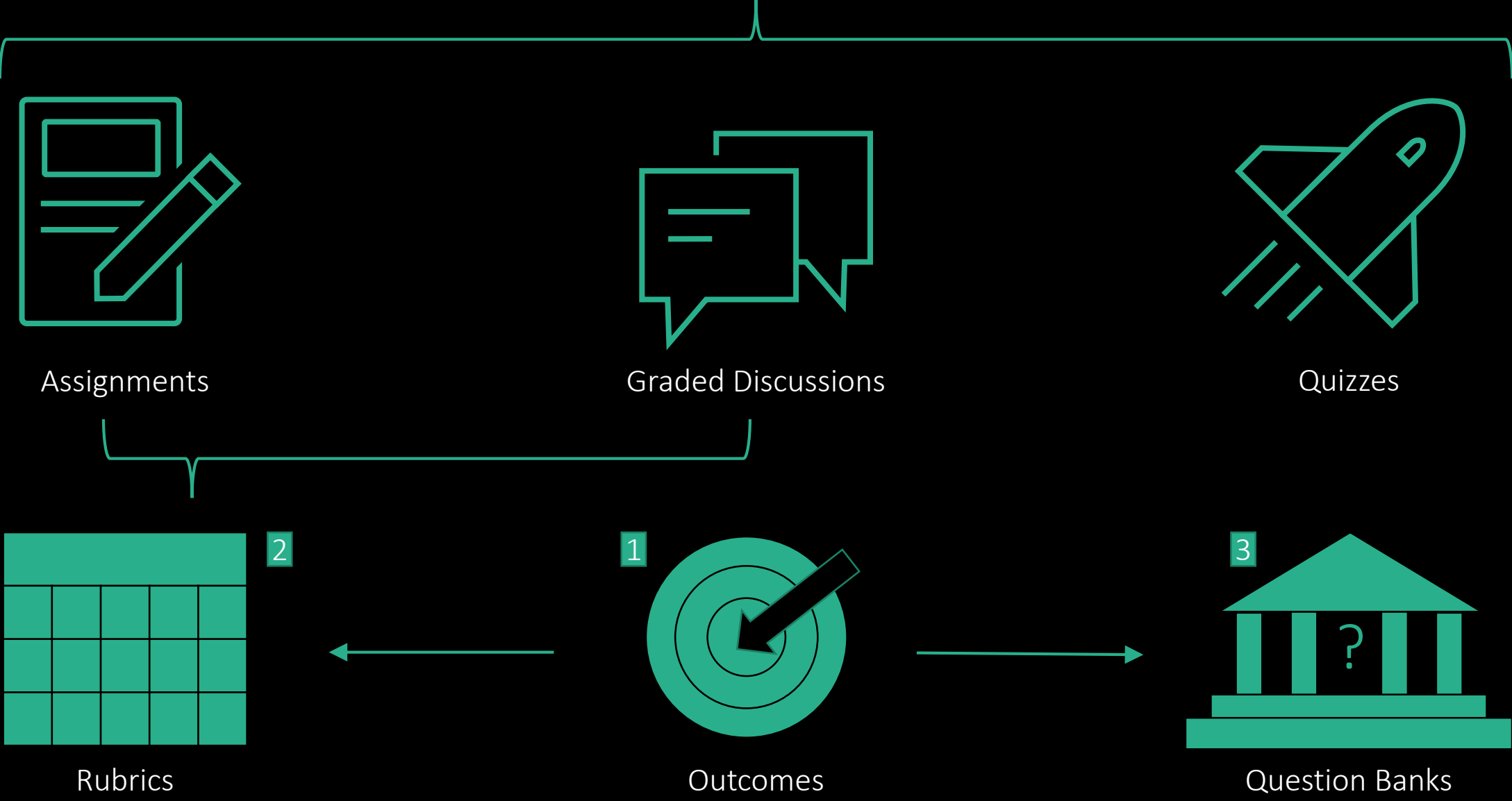

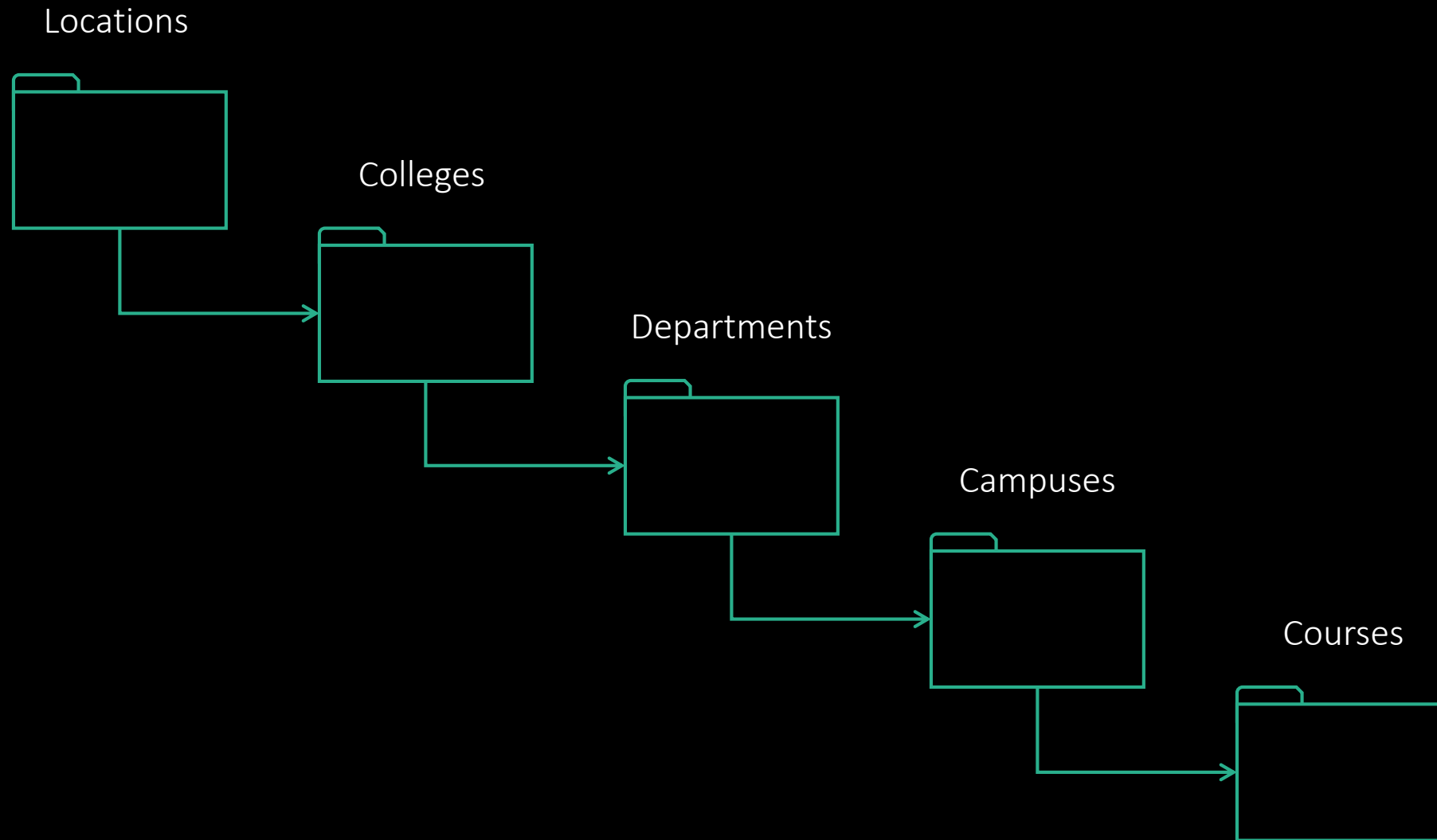

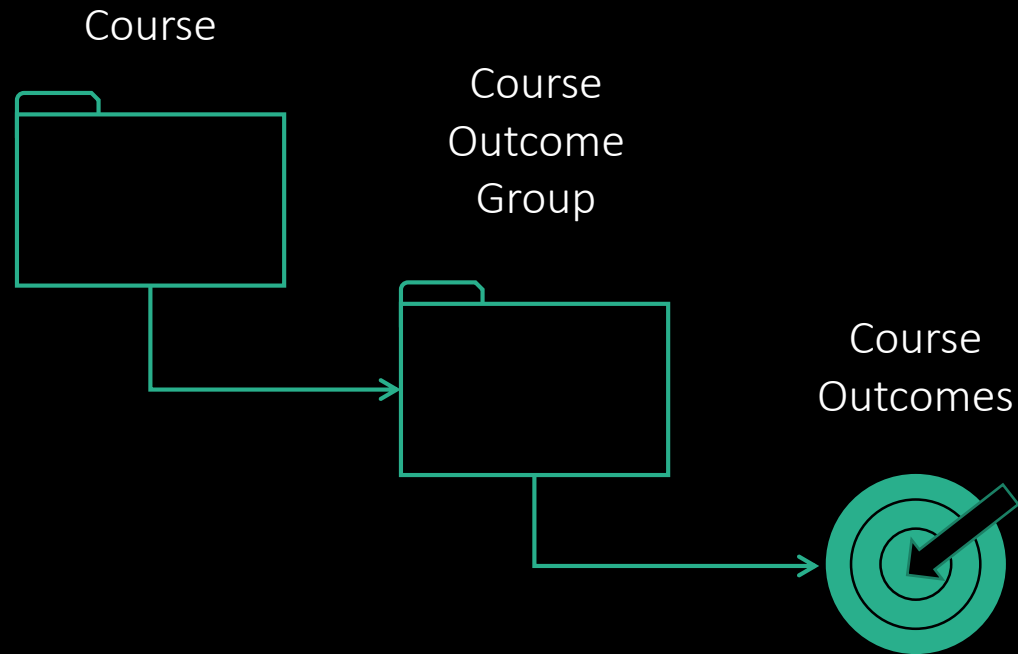
Leverage Touro's Canvas Framework

- The Canvas sub-account (institutional) hierarchy:
 - Mimics the structure of Banner's course catalogue.
 - Enables academic administrators to create school-specific grade schemes, question banks, rubrics, and outcomes which are available to all downstream courses.
 - Enables academic administrators to run outcome reports for all downstream courses with assignments that are aligned to institutional outcomes.

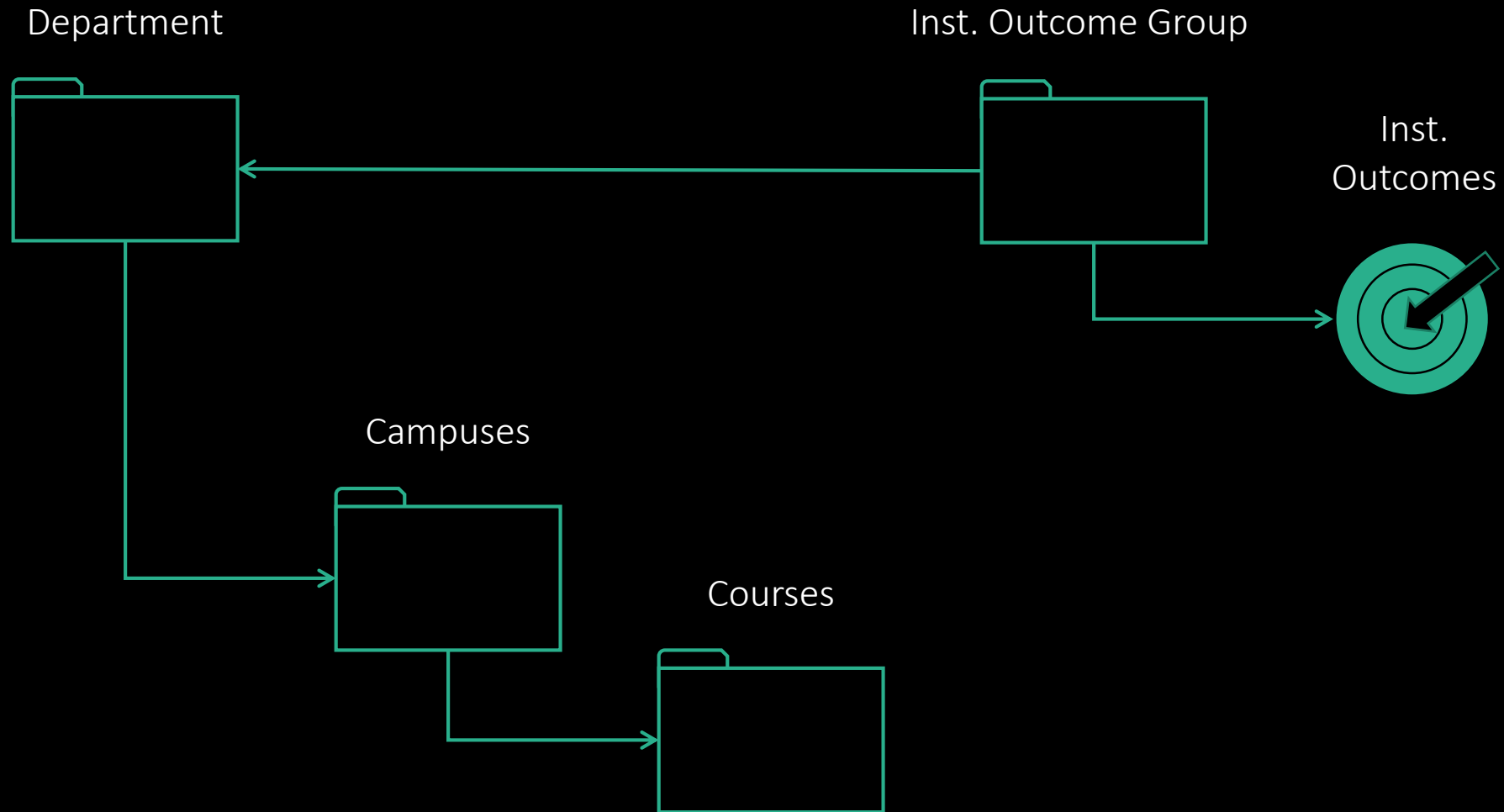
TCUS Canvas Institutional Hierarchy
